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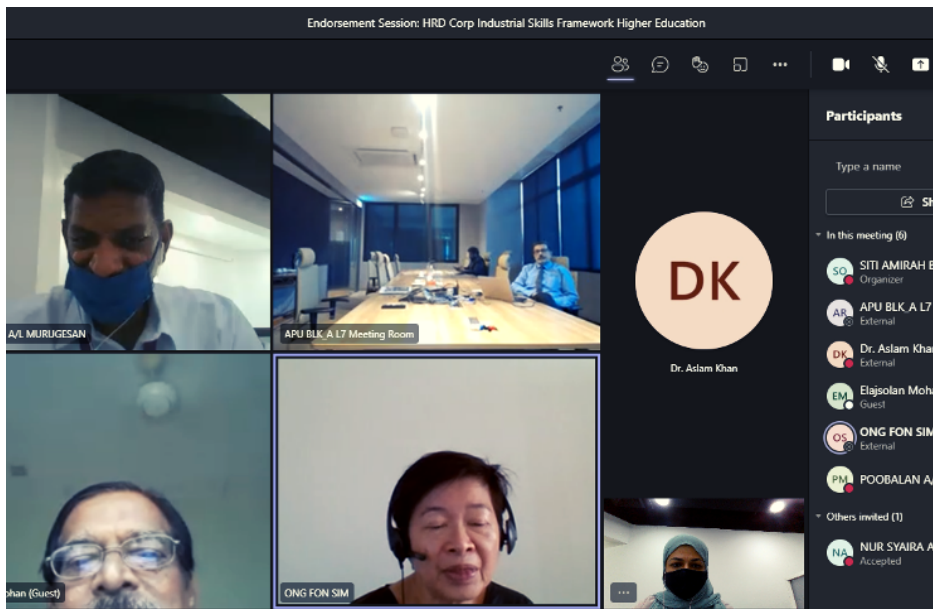

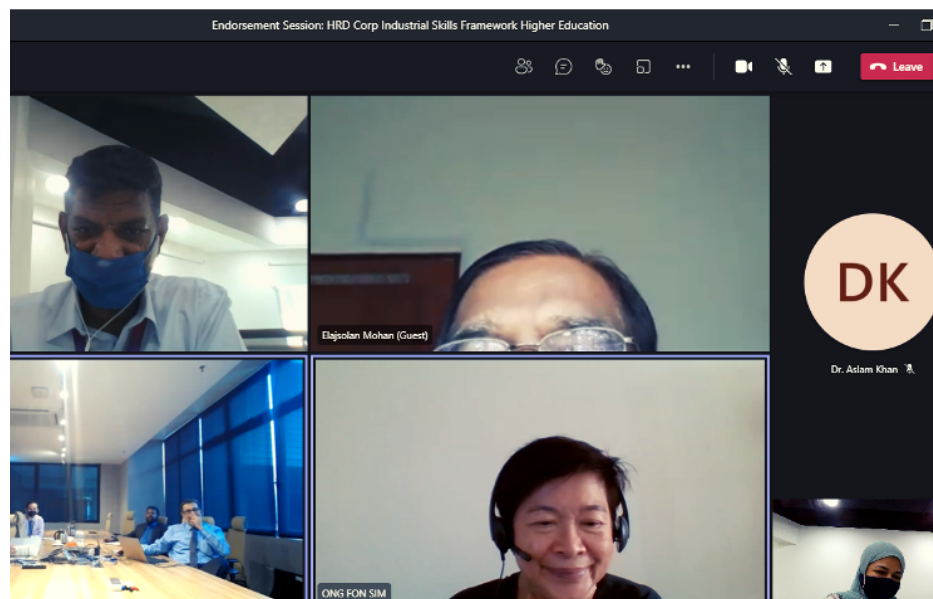

Purpose: Obtain an endorsement from the collaborators for the IndSF for Logistics and Warehousing.

The Validation Sessions for all IndSF for Logistics and Warehousing focus areas have been completed and reviewed by the appointed validators. The documents of IndSF for Logistics and Warehousing have been consolidated and sent to the collaborators for their endorsement on 23 November 2021. The Endorsement session with the main collaborators (FMFF, SFFLA & IATA) on the final IndSF document was held on 29 November 2021.

During this session, the Secretariat presented all of the documents for IndSF for Logistics and Warehousing, and the collaborators gave their feedback and comments. Some minor amendments needed to be made before the collaborators could approve the document for publication.

Job Description :	
Freightling Clerk is responsible to manage and execute the import/ export and oversee goods movement from one location to another. Freightling Clerk jobs involve charging, costing and arranging the movement of goods and flow of paperwork to ensure necessary clearances are obtained quickly and deliveries are made in good time.	
Responsibilities may include:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arranging and completing all associated paperwork, which documents the nature of the goods being move from one location to another and that they are legal and legitimate . • Ensure the accuracy of Bill of Lading. • Liaise with inbound and outbound offices, partners and agents.

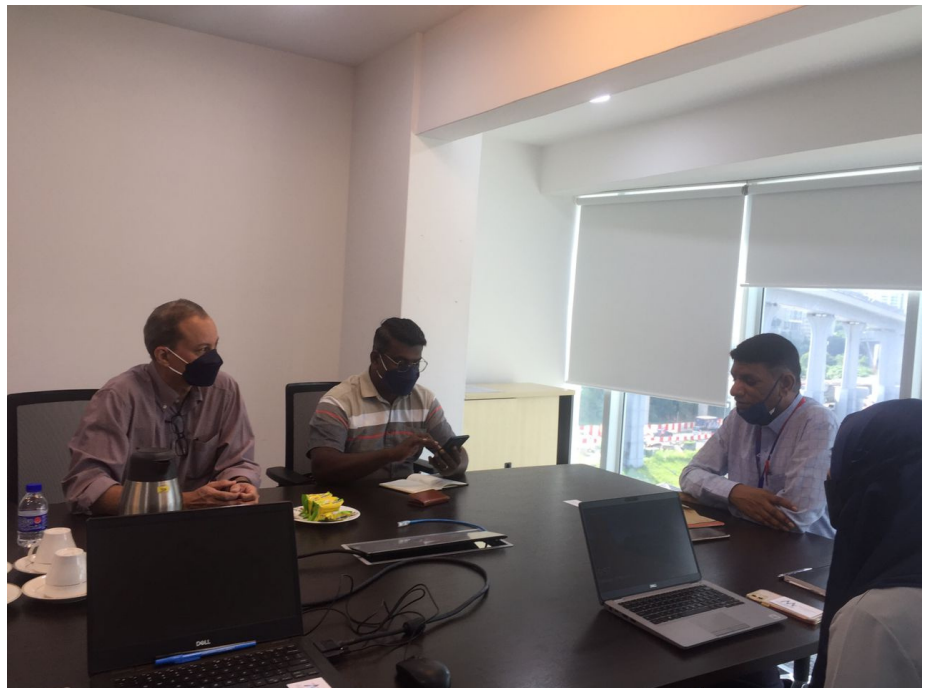

Enhancement Activities in November

The potential IndSF sub-sectors to be enhanced in 2022 are:

- ▲ IndSF for Machinery & Equipment (Welding)
- ▲ IndSF for Oil, Gas & Energy (Coating Fingerprinting)
- ▲ IndSF for Aerospace (Maintenance, Repair & Overhaul (MRO))

The IndSF Unit received the Career Pathways and Job & Skills Descriptions draft for IndSF Enhancement: Machinery and Equipment at the end of October 2021.

We have invited the collaborators, the Machinery & Equipment Manufacturers Association (MEMA) and the Malaysian Welding and Joining Society (MWJS), to a physical meeting at HRD Corp HQ.

The collaborators have agreed to make some enhancements to the document and send the revised version to the Secretariat.

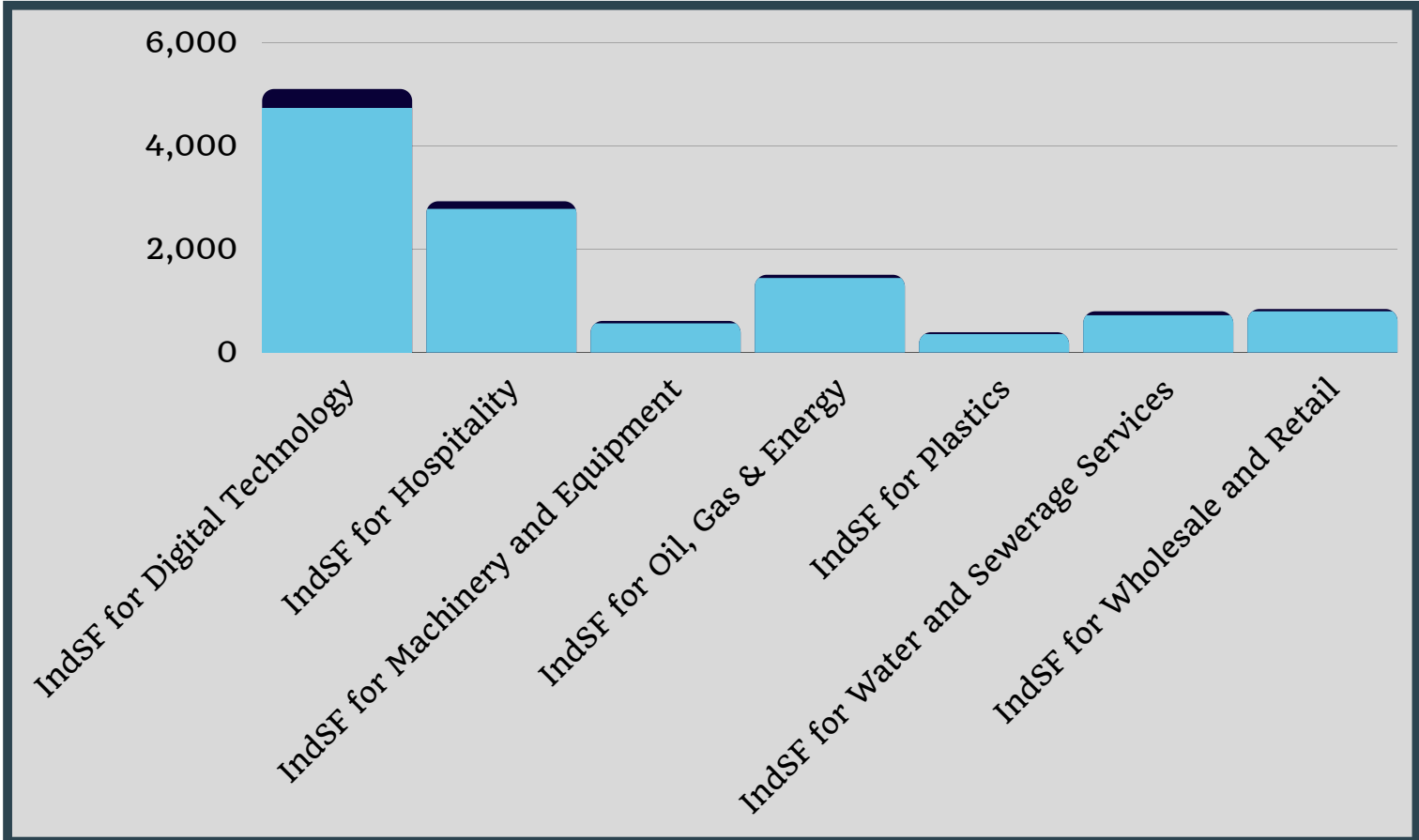
