IndSF Wood-Based Industry

- The IndSF Unit with the assistance of the Malaysian Wood Industries Association (MWIA) is currently exploring the potential of nominating more collaborators to participate in the IndSF development initiative.



IndSF Telecommunications

- Currently, 14 subject matter experts (SME) have been identified with the assistance of collaborators. This number is expected to increase as we actively seek for more SMEs to join the initiative.
- The first workshop for IndSF Telecommunications is scheduled to take place on 17th July 2023.



IndSF Agriculture (Non-Perennial Crops)

- The first workshop for the focus area of Pineapples has been conducted with eight (8) SMEs in attendance.
- The IndSF Unit is actively pursuing more SMEs to be recommended by the Department of Agriculture (DOA) and Felda Holdings Berhad (FGV).

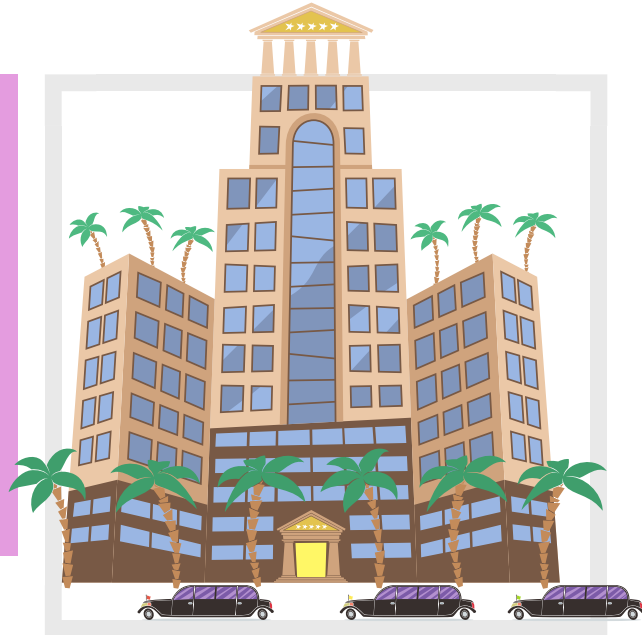


IndSF Digital Technology

- The first workshop has been conducted for both focus areas of Cybersecurity and Data Science.
- Career pathways for both of the focus areas have been revised based on the recommendations provided during the workshop sessions.
- Currently, subject matter experts are reviewing the job positions and skills under both focus areas.

IndSF Hospitality - Hotel

- The first workshop has been conducted with 11 SMEs and collaborators in attendance including the Malaysian Association of Hotels (MAH) and the Malaysia Budget Hotel Association (MyBHA).
- The second workshop has been conducted on 27th June 2023 for the focus area of Sales & Marketing.



IndSF Apparel & Footwear

- The first workshop has been conducted with 13 SMEs and collaborators in attendance, including the Malaysia Textile Manufacturers Association (MTMA) and the Malaysian Footwear Manufacturers Association (MFMA).
- The tentative date for the second workshop has been proposed by SMEs for 19th July 2023, in a face-to-face session.

Sectorial Training Committees (STCs)



- The STCs will be conducting four meeting sessions annually to discuss the current training needs within the industry.
- As of 30th June 2023, 22 out of 26 STCs have successfully conducted their second meeting sessions.

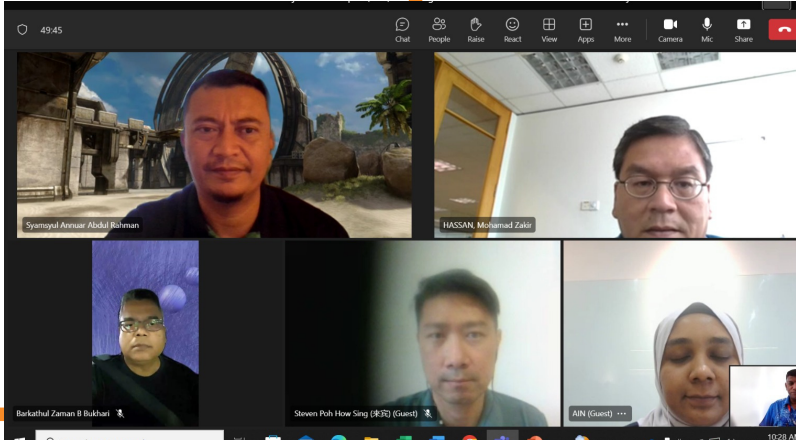

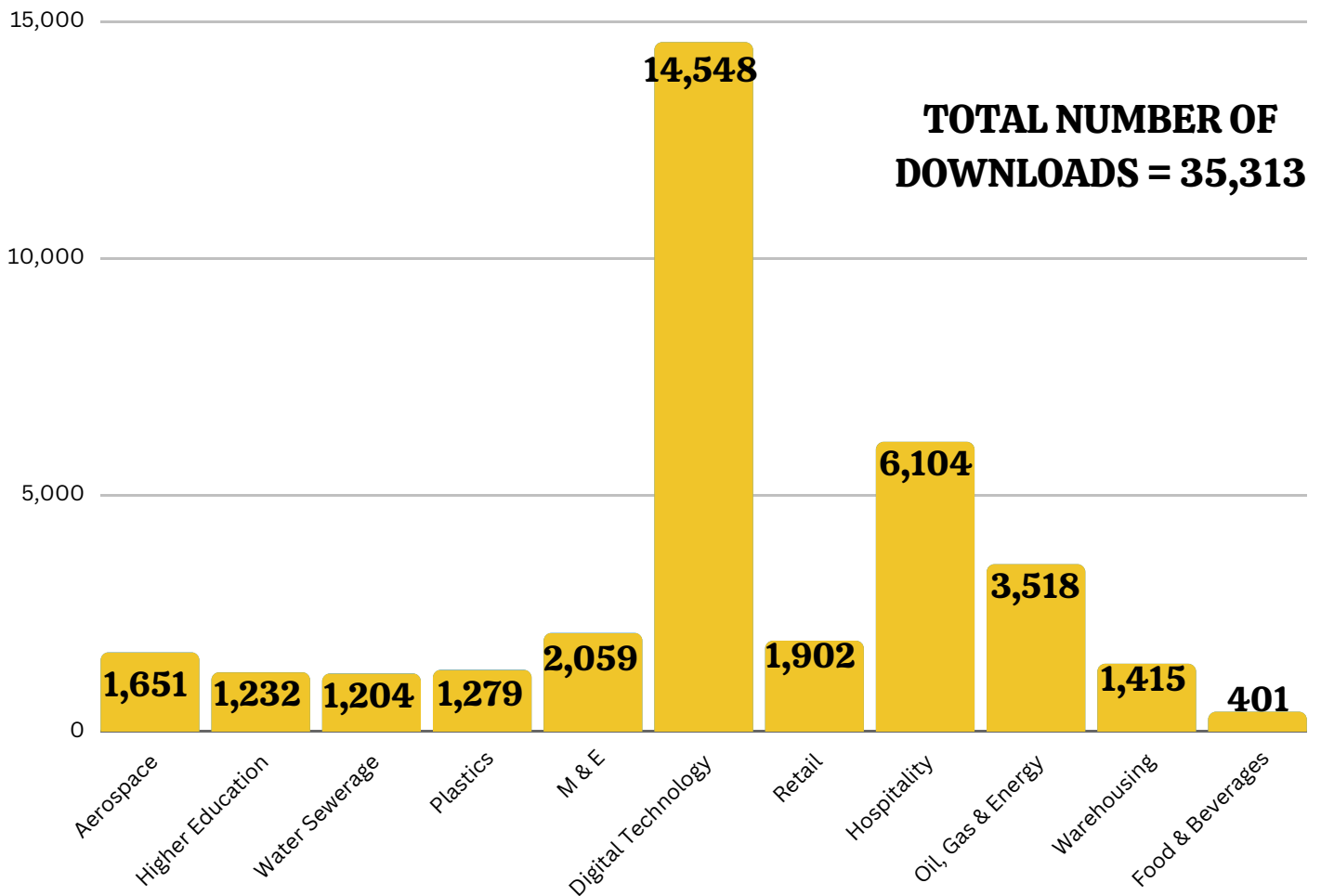
