

As we closely monitor the download count of IndSF documents from the HRD Corp portal, we're pleased to share a significant accomplishment: a consistent surge of 1,773 downloads in August 2023, highlighting the growing recognition of IndSF's value in Malaysia's human capital development landscape. Notably, we've achieved a significant milestone by accumulating a total of 40,940 downloads in the year 2023 so far. Our proactive engagement with industry players through webinars and workshops underscores our dedication to raising awareness about the pivotal role that these documents play. Looking forward, our unwavering commitment to fostering collaboration and embracing innovation propels our roadmap to craft new IndSF documents in collaboration with diverse industries.

- On 9th August 2023, we held a virtual meeting between the Industrial Skills Framework (IndSF) Unit and the Menteri Besar Selangor (Incorporated) team to discuss how we may work together to make the IndSF document more accessible, usable, and effective.
