### IndSF DEVELOPMENT



### IndSF Agriculture Non-Perennial Crops (Pineapple)

The development of IndSF Agriculture Non-Perennial Crops (Pineapple) has been successfully completed with endorsement of the document by collaborators (FGV, MPIB, MPC and MDEC) in two endorsement sessions conducted on 13 and 14 December 2023. A total of eight job positions have been identified by nine Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) through three workshop sessions and the job positions have been validated by three validators.

#### **IndSF Drone Technology**

The document for IndSF Drone Technology has completed its development process with endorsements from collaborative entities, MRANTI and MAIA, in a session conducted on 19 December 2023. Mr. Farhan of MRANTI and Mr. Uzair of MAIA were present at the endorsement session. Across two workshop sessions, 11 SMEs identified a cumulative total of eight job positions related to the IndSF Drone Technology document. These positions were later validated by two appointed validators.





#### **IndSF Telecommunications**

The IndSF Telecommunications document has successfully undergone the development process. receiving endorsements collaborating entities (Telekom Malaysia, Maxis Broadband Sdn Bhd, Celcom Digi Berhad, Measat, MCMC, and DNB) during an endorsement session held on 19 December 2023. The session was attended by key collaborators, SMEs, and validators. Through five workshop sessions, 11 SMEs identified a total of 31 job positions for the IndSF Telecommunications document, which were subsequently validated by three appointed validators.









### IndSF ENHANCEMENT



### IndSF Apparel & Footwear (Manufacturing)

The completion of the IndSF Apparel & Footwear (Manufacturing) enhancements was marked by the endorsement of the document by collaborators, from (MKMA, MFMA, and MTMA). The endorsement sessions, held on Monday, 18 December 2023, involved 19 SMEs identifying 65 job positions across five workshop sessions. Subsequently, eight validators validated these identified positions.

#### **IndSF Hospitality**

IndSF Hospitality document has successfully completed its development obtaining endorsements from process, collaborative entities, namely the Malaysian Association of Hotels (MAH) and the Malaysia Budget & Business Hotel Association (MyBHA), during an endorsement session held on 18 December 2023. Across six workshop sessions, three SMEs identified a total of 61 job positions outlined in the IndSF Hospitality document. These positions underwent validation by five appointed validators, focusing on five key areas:

- a. Front Office
- b. Housekeeping
- c. Revenue Management
- d. Sales & Marketing
- e. Maintenance





### IndSF Digital Technology (Data Science)

The completion of the IndSF Digital Technology (Data Science) enhancements was marked by the endorsement of the document by collaborators, from (MDEC, MNCC, MPC, PIKOM, and CyberSecurity). The endorsement sessions occurred a few days from 13 to 18 December 2023. A total of 15 job positions were identified by six SMEs through eight workshop sessions, and these positions subsequently validated were validators.

# STC Hospitality 4th Meeting



The 4th session of the STC Hospitality meeting centred on strategising action plans for the upcoming year (2024). The focus was on equipping the industry with updated insights on training and development opportunities through a series of engagement sessions. Additionally, this meeting welcomed two new associations, the Malaysian Association of Convention & Exhibition Organisers & Suppliers (MACEOS) and the Malaysian Food & Beverage Executives Association (MFBEA), attending as guests and slated to join as STC Hospitality members soon.

The 4th STC Oil, Gas & Energy meeting focused on insights and strategic input to identify skills and training requirements for established and emerging technologies within the industry.
